

# WATCHDOG 900: Cleaning the Gravity Drain



## **Tools:**

- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- **-OR-**
- #2 Phillips Drill
- Cleaning Solution (choose one of the following) :
  - **Option #1-** (4 ounces white vinegar) + (12 ounces water)
  - **Option #2-** (1 ounce bleach) + (15 ounces water)
- 16 ounces clean water

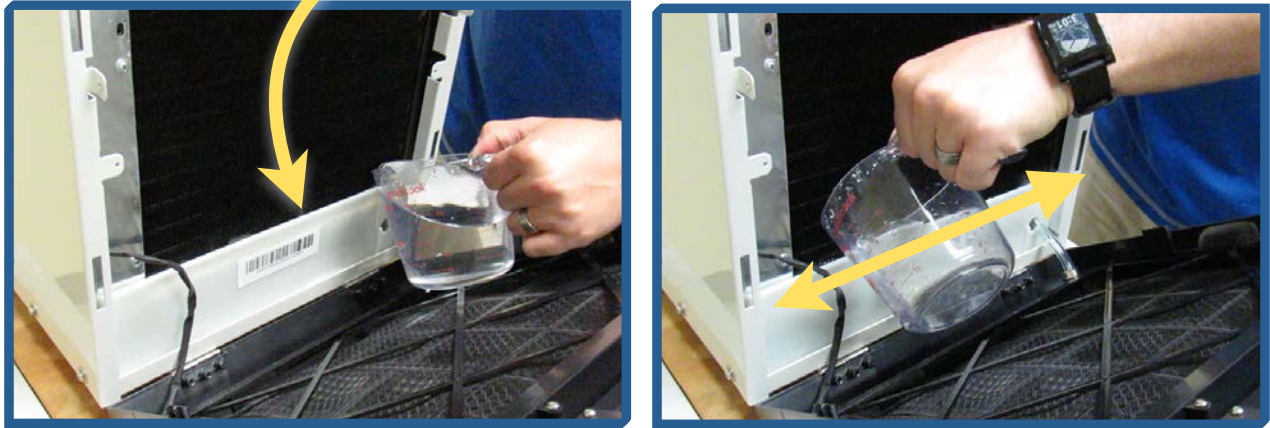
1. First, mix your cleaning solution using one of the options listed above.
2. Next, you will need to open the end cap so you have access to the gravity drain. To do this, use the screwdriver or drill to remove the screws (one on each side of the end cap).

*NOTE: If you have moved your dehumidifier out of the crawl space, make sure the drain line has somewhere to drain, prior to proceeding to the next step.*



3. Once the end cap is open, slowly pour the cleaning solution into the drain train. Continue pouring all of the cleaning solution, moving from side to side to evenly distribute it.

4. Let the cleaning solution soak for 10-15 minutes.

5. After the cleaning solution has soaked, pour in the clean water to flush out the drain line. Move from side to side to evenly distribute, just as you did with the cleaning solution.



6. Finally, close up the end cap, and secure the two screws (one on each side).



7. Repeat this process at least once a year (depending on the environment).
